

WHEN AND WHERE??

- Pat's Peak, Henniker, NH approximately 2 hours from Mansfield.
- Saturdays January 20 and February 10
- Leave QMS @ 6:00am, arrive at Pat's Peak around 8:15am
- Ski 8:30am-3:30pm, board bus to leave @ 4:00 PM
- Arrive back at QMS around 6:00 PM



Costs and Fees

Each amount below is total for both dates:

- Mandatory Lift Pass--\$118
- Mandatory Bus Fee--\$95

Minimum total-- \$213

Extras, only if needed/wanted:

- Ski Rentals/Snowboard Rentals = \$76
- Helmet Rental = \$ 20
- 1 Hour Lessons = \$ 80



In order to get these great student discounts, Pat's Peak and Bloom requires us to purchase tickets up front. So, if you have an issue or conflict - please realize that the entire fee is non refundable

Transportation

- Transportation will be by coach bus
- 50 kids per bus + 5 chaperones
- Students are assigned buses typically based on grade
- Food will be allowed on busses, provided that all trash is picked up.
- Students can bring movies to watch on the bus. Each bus can vote on a movie. They must be appropriate and approved by bus chaperones.
- The bus company has the ultimate say in it's policy on food, as well as, expectations of behavior and consequence.



Medical Information

- The Pat's Peak Ski Patrol will assist chaperones in determining the best course of action if an injury should occur. <u>PARENTS WILL BE CONTACTED</u> for all injuries that report to ski patrol.
- In the event of an injury, a parent or guardian may need to drive to Pat's Peak to take home or stay with their child.
- A chaperone will always stay with the child until a parent arrives.



Important Rules



Students will adhere to the rules of the QMS student code of conduct, as listed in the student Handbook. Students who violate any of the ski club's policies and procedures or any rules as defined in the code of conduct will be referred to the building Administration and may have any future trips revoked WITHOUT REFUND

The following rules that are specific to the QMS Ski Club will also apply:

- 1. Any student heard CURSING/USING VULGARITIES will have their badge/pass marked. If this occurs a 2nd time, the student will be banned from future trip with NO REFUND
- 2. Proper behavior in the lodge includes: No skis or snowboards in the building; picking up after yourself, removing trash from tables and returning cafeteria trays; keeping stairs, doorways and aisles clear at all times. Horseplay, shoving, running, throwing food, etc. may result in loss of ski club privilege.
- 3. You must follow the ski etiquette and rules of Pat's Peak. This includes storing equipment correctly, skiing on marked trails only, skiing in control and no horseplay in ski lines.
- 4 WEARING A HELMET when you are on the slopes is mandatory.
- 5. Members of QMS Ski Club are given a lot of freedom and independence when at the mountain. Chaperones will facilitate the BUDDY SYSTEM so no one is skiing alone. We expect this to be reinforced from home and for you and your child to adhere to the buddy system wherever they are at Pat's Peak.

2024 Student Reminders and Expectations

• BE RESPECTFUL, RESPONSIBLE, AND KIND

Be polite to one another, respect the adults around, and control your actions.

Students are expected to conduct themselves according to all QMS rules, according to the handbook. This is a school trip

On the bus:

- No Switching Buses. Ride the bus you are assigned**
- Stay in your seat.
- Misbehaving on the bus, including vulgar language, horseplay, disrespecting a student,
 chaperone, or driver, will result in a suspension or dismissal from the program.
- Food and drinks are welcome on the bus. YOU MUST CLEAN UP AFTER YOURSELF. Messy buses may results in a loss of this privilege.
- Chaperones will notify students when we are 15-20 minutes from Mansfield, so they can text parents for a ride home.

2024 Student Reminders and Expectations

At Pat's Peak:

- When we get to the mountain, you should stay in your seat on the bus until the chaperones tell you it is time to go.
- Always ski/snowboard with someone else there is safety in numbers. BUDDY SYSTEM!
 If you are struggling to find someone to ski with, please let a chaperone know
- We will set up a QMS base camp in the lodge. There will always be chaperones there, but you are still
 responsible for your own belongings. Lockers are available if you want to use them.
- You may bring your own food and drinks for snacks and lunch, or you can bring extra money for food/snacks. Stay hydrated throughout the day!
- No skis or boards are allowed in the lodge at any time. You may place your skis and boards
 outside on the racks or put them in the "ski watch" area.
- We end our outings and DEPART for home at exactly 4:00PM. Make sure you are there, on the bus and ready by that time. Start returning any gear and getting ready early (around 3:30PM). We will not tolerate lateness. Your skiing/boarding privileges may be taken away, or you may lose your privileges to attend future outings if you are late.
- We are looking forward to many great trips. Hopefully, you have fun, make some new friends, and represent yourselves and QMS well!

CHAPERONE DETAILS

Chaperone Responsibilities?

- Serve as a group leader and will be responsible for about 10-15 kids.
- Handing out lift passes on the bus
- Helping students know when and where the group will meet and where the home base is in the lodge.
- Assist with rentals and making sure they know where to go for lessons.
- Enjoy some time on the slopes. (Keeping an eye out for our students, of course)
 - Chaperones receive free lift ticket
- All chaperones are asked to help load and unload the bus.
